Housing as a Platform for Equitable Learning Recovery

July 18–22, 2022

The 2022 All-America City Awards will recognize communities that have engaged housing developments, organizations and agencies in promising efforts to accelerate equitable academic and economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic. The Awards will lift up and celebrate collaborative initiatives that meet families “where they are” through a 24/7/365/2G approach and that work with parents and children, recognizing that both are essential predictors of success.

Applicants will be asked to discuss how interagency agreements, cross-sector initiatives and strategic deployment of civic capital — through formal and informal relationships, networks and capacities — combine to produce better early school success outcomes through improved data sharing, problem-solving and smart decision-making.
